# MACONNAIS MEETS BEAUJOLAIS PORT: MACON (BEAUNE), FRANCE | MONDAY, JULY 22, 2019 | 9:15 AM - 4:15 PM\*

The town of Mâcon enjoys a unique location in Burgundy as its southern most region while simultaneously overlapping the northern part of the Beaujolais region. This tour is designed to show you both. As you explore the Mâconnais region, you will have the opportunity to taste some excellent white wines from prominent appellations such as Pouilly-Fuissé and Saint-Véran. Often overshadowed by the whites from the Côte d'Or to the north, these wines offer enormous value. Due to Mâcon's proximity to Beaujolais, you will also experience the vivid and fresh reds from the Gamay grape that has become synonymous with this region.



**ROCK OF SOLUTRÉ** 

Start with a scenic motor coach drive as you meander through the Pouilly-Fuissé and Saint-Véran vineyards. Here you will catch glimpses of both the Rock of Solutré and the Rock of Vergisson - large limestone escarpments that tower above the rolling vineyards dotted with quaint villages. You will also enjoy a stunning view of the Château de Pierreclos before climbing granite hills to the village of Cenves, where you will arrive at your first destination, an organic goat cheese farm. La Ferme des P'tis Bilounes is owned by a passionate young couple, Anne-Marie and Thierry Douard who chose this idyllic hillside location for its magnificent

views that extend all the way to Mount Blanc on a clear day. After a warm greeting, Anne-Maire and Thierry will explain why the soil and surrounding vegetation makes their cheese so special, while a nearby winemaker friend will discuss the Gamay grape and his Beaujolais wines in a guided cheese and wine tasting.

A short drive brings you to your second stop, the 14<sup>th</sup> century *Château de* Chasselas, where the owner Jean-Marc Veyron la Croix will welcome the group for a guided tour and tasting. Bordering both Burgundy and Beaujolais, the estate produces excellent Gamay-based reds as well as white, rosé and sparkling wines from the Pouilly-Fuissé and Saint-Véran appellations. Jean Marc will also accompany the group for a wine-paired lunch, held in either the château gardens or inside the former cuvage depending on the weather.

After saying goodbye to Jean Marc, depart for the near-by village of Fuissé which has given its name to the famed Pouilly Fuissé AOC. Mme Vincent, the owner of the *Château de Fuissé*, will welcome you to her impressive estate. After a stroll through their emblematic vineyard "Le Clos," solely owned by the Vincent Family, and a visit of their cellar you will enjoy a tasting of their wines in one of the château's 15<sup>th</sup> century rooms before heading back to the ship.

# PARKER'S PASSION FOR CHATEAUNEUF-DU-PAPE Port: Avignon, France | Friday, July 26, 2019 | 9:30 AM – 4:00 PM\*

TIME Magazine described Robert Parker Jr. as, "the man with the paragon palate... for countless wine lovers, Robert Parker's tastes are infallible." Wine lovers across the globe look to his ratings to influence their

wine cellar selections. For Parker the choice is simple, the bottle he reaches for the most comes from Châteauneuf-du-Pape. What is behind Parker's passionate crush? He explains, "The greatest appeal of Châteauneuf-du-Pape, beyond its foodfriendly qualities, expansiveness, generosity of flavors and sumptuous texture, is the almost addictive attraction of its combined intellectual and hedonistic elements."

Less than 60 miles from Marseille, Châteauneuf-du-Pape is your destination for

the day and your guide is an American-born and French-trained superstar sommelier. His goal is to

educate you and your palate on what makes Châteauneuf-du-Pape such a classic wine region. The first stop is the highly respected, awardwinning winery, *Domaine de la Janasse*. With wines consistently rated in the 90s by *Wine Advocate* and *Wine Spectator*, Janasse, has become synonymous with excellence in the wine world.

Lunch will be served at nearby chef-owned restaurant, La Table de Sorgues. The menu, made with fresh ingredients and full of flavorful foods, is paired with a selection of regional wines.

Next, just north of the village of Châteauneuf-du-Pape is *Alain Jaume Domaine Grand Veneur*. Dating back to 1826, the family winery is now in its fifth generation of wine makers. Although one of perhaps

the first wineries to experiment with using new French oak for aging, Alain's sons, Sebastien and Christophe have continued in their father's footsteps with organic viticulture, green-harvesting and manual harvesting.
