PORT: DUBROVNIK, CROATIA | SATURDAY, NOVEMBER 09, 2019 | 9:30 AM – 4:00 PM*

Croatian wines have been steadily gaining a presence in today's world market. The epicenter of the Croatian wine industry is Dubrovnik, the birthplace of California's Zinfandel grape and one of this region's superstar wineries is *Korta Katarina*. Learn the connection between Croatian wines and California Zinfandel and experience the beautiful, medieval city of Dubrovnik!



UNESCO HERITAGE CITY OF DUBROVNIK

Dubrovnik is also famous for its great beauty and tragic past. On a guided walking tour, delve into its magical ambiance and tantalizing stories. Begin at the city's famous main street, the Stradun, and wander through centuries old cobblestone streets. Visit historic sites including the famed Sponza and Rectors Palaces, Onofrio's fountain, and the beautifully decorated Romanesque Cathedral. In 1979 Dubrovnik was designated as a UNESCO World Heritage Site. After witnessing the pristine condition of the city and its buildings, you will be amazed to learn that it was twice devastated, once by earthquake in 1667 that leveled the town, and then again in 1991 by bombs during the Yugoslavian civil war.

Following your tour of the city, you'll continue on to one of our favorite local restaurants for a sommelier led wine tasting with Korta Katarina wines. As past trustees of the Naples Winter Wine Festival, Korta Katarina winery owners, Lee and Penny Anderson, met with great success pursuing their passion for winemaking after moving to Croatia from the U.S. Among their many international awards, *Wine Enthusiast* has rated several of their vintages in the 90s. Enjoy a wine-paired, delicious four-course meal featuring modern Croatian cuisine.

After lunch, the remainder of the afternoon is yours to continue exploring this charming city on your own.

NAPLES CULINARY TOUR

PORT: NAPLES, ITALY | WEDNESDAY, NOVEMBER 13, 2019 | 10:00 AM – 3:15 PM*

Join a Neapolitan food expert on an adventure through the heart of one of the world's oldest cities whose traditions and heritage are best understood when all of your senses are engaged! From the port of Naples meet your expert, local guide directly at the pier. From there, you will set out for a walking tour of this bustling metropolis while uncovering the gastronomic culture of Naples through its history, anecdotes and legends.

Learn the intricacies of the Neapolitan coffee rituals with a bracing cup of espresso. Discover the rich architecture hidden above the narrow, winding streets of this ancient city as you stroll through the Spanish Quarter and the beautiful cloister garden of Santa Chiara. Along the way, you will stop and taste several of Naples' most well-loved specialties such as sfogliatella, "wallet" pizza, cuopo fritto, the true rum baba, as well as local beer and wine.



For a truly unique, in-depth look at this historical town, you will also pay a visit to Naples underground. Descend the lively streets almost 40 meters and travel 2,400 years into the past to the very heart of Naples - the place from which the city was born. This now underground "museum" holds a labyrinth of channels which were used for centuries as water reservoirs. Later, during WWII, they were cleared of water and transformed into air-raid shelters. See the progression of time as your guide directs you through this intriguing network below the urban streets.

At the end of your walking tour you will be free to continue exploring Naples on your own or follow your guide back to the pier. Total walking distance in Naples is about 3 miles with several stops along the way.

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THE SUPER TUSCANS OF ITALY – ORNELLAIA

PORT: LIVORNO, ITALY | FRIDAY, NOVEMBER 15, 2019 | 9:00 AM – 4:00 PM*

You are invited to spend a day 'under the Tuscan Sun' to visit one of the few wineries in the world that can boast a perfect "100" rating from Wine Spectator!

Considered to be "rebels" of the wine world, the term "Super Tuscan" came into vogue in the late 1980s, when a handful of reds from the Italian region of Tuscany gained some international attention. The wines were sold as "vini da tavola," or table wines, because their use of international varietals, principally Cabernet Sauvignon, made them ineligible for official wine categories. They were "super" Tuscan reds—superior in quality and outside of official premium wine designations.

You will start the day's journey with a brief stop in the medieval town of *Bolgheri*, to whet your palate with a tasting of three super wines from three different Tuscan coastline DOC regions.

From there, continue on to one of the most celebrated Tuscan wine estates, *Tenuta dell'Ornellaia*, and discover for yourself what compels the wine industry's top publications to include their wines in their annual list of 'top wines' over and over, year after year. Your visit begins with a walking tour through the estate's famed *Bellaria Vineyard*, stand under its 150-year-old oak tree and hear the history of this beautiful and unspoiled land. A land that has become synonymous with winemaking of the first order and has seen the birth of such great labels such as: *Ornellaia*, *Le Serre Nuove dell'Ornellaia*, *Masseto* and *Le Volte*. Here, the winemaking philosophy is "quality without compromise," and you will experience this integrity first-hand during a tasting of several of their varietals, followed by a traditional Tuscan four-course lunch at the winery paired with a selection of current releases.


VERONA, ITALY | 2-NIGHT PRE-CRUISE PROGRAM | NOVEMBER 5-7, 2019

This is your opportunity to visit two of Italy's great wine regions, Valpolicella and Soave, combining the elements of an exclusive deluxe, pre-cruise experience with the enjoyment and conviviality of traveling with a group of fellow wine lovers.

Food & Wine Trails has created a two-night pre-cruise experience that begins with a private car and driver from either the Venice International or Verona Municipal Airports to the beautiful Valpolicella wine region, known for producing Amarone, one of Italy's biggest and most prestigious red wines. Accompanied for two days by our local wine expert and sommelier, you will also visit the wine region of Soave where some of Italy's finest white wines are now being produced.

Medieval Verona is situated an hour and a half west of Venice along the banks of the Adige River. Set in the nearby Verona countryside, your peaceful sanctuary for the next two nights will be the *Villa Quaranta Tommasi Wine Hotel & Spa*.

One of the most well-known tales of tragedy and romance set in Verona is William Shakespeare's *Romeo & Juliet*. The story has

touched so many hearts over the centuries that even today people come to Verona from all over the world to leave notes for Juliet, to see her balcony and to experience this beautifully intact medieval city.

DAY 1 – INDEPENDENT ARRIVAL IN VERONA [D]

Upon arrival at the airport in Venice or Verona, you will enjoy the services of a private car and driver for your journey to the *Villa Quaranta Tommasi Wine Hotel & Spa*. Surrounded by the Valpolicella countryside, the four-star hotel's grounds include a classically restored 17th century villa and

Romanesque church. Included with the tour package is entrance to the *Terme della Valpolicella Wellness Center* and *Thernarium Spa*, including both indoor and outdoor pools, Finnish sauna, a cold cave, whirlpools, and Turkish baths.

That evening, join your local wine expert for a welcome dinner at the hotel's *Cantina in Villa*, where local specialties will be paired with the Tommasi Valpolicella and Amarone wines.

DAY 2 – DISCOVERING VALPOLICELLA [B,L]

Enjoy breakfast served in the hotel's restaurant before meeting your guide and departing for a full day in Valpolicella.

Your guide for both days is a long-time friend of Food & Wine Trails and a Veneto wine specialist. Canadian born, Tamara is a certified sommelier living in Venice, who when not hosting wine tasting groups is working with the designers and curators of Venice's famed La Biennale di Venezia



ALBINO ARMANI

Depart the hotel for a 20 minute drive to the *Albino Armani* estate. The estate's foundation dates back to 1962 in the Veneto region, but the Armani family's first vineyard was documented in 1607, when Domenico Armani inherited his father's property planted with "grapes and trees." Armani has estates in the Tri-Veneto area, the ancient lands of the *Serenissima*: Trentino, Friuli and Veneto. We will have a chance to taste his prosecco "sur lie" followed by a selection of the finest wines of their estates in Valpolicella Classico.



VALPOLICELLA COUNTRYSIDE

Depart the estate and drive a short distance in the beautiful Valpolicella countryside for a wine-paired luncheon at *Trattoria Al Caprini Restaurant*. This family-run trattoria continues to charm with mother, Pierina, kneading and rolling out ribbons upon ribbons of light fresh pasta every day. Sons Sergio and Davide help in front of house and kitchen. The menu will consist of local specialties with a selection of hard-to-find, local Valpolicellas and Amarones.

After lunch, you will return to the hotel and are free to go into Verona and explore on your own, or just indulge yourself with a treatment at the hotel's spa. Dinner this evening is on your own.

DAY 3 – SOAVE & TRANSFER TO THE SHIP [B, L]

Check-out of your room and then enjoy breakfast in the hotel's restaurant. Meet Tamara in the lobby with your luggage and board the motor coach.

Depart the Villa Quaranta and drive approximately one hour to the Soave wine region and the small Veneto *comune* of the same name. The inhabitants of Soave were protected by an impressive medieval castle that was built by the Scala family in the 13th century – yes, the same Scala family that gives the name to the opera house in Milan. Our winery visit and tasting is a short distance away at *Suavia Winery*. Owned by the Tessari Family, the winery's name alludes to the pre modern-day references to Soave. The Tessari's have been farming the native *Garganega* and *Trebbiano di Soave* white varietals in the volcanic hills of *Soave Classico* since the late 1800's, founding their modern winery in 1990. Tamara will guide you through an informative tour and tasting of their wines.

Lunch today will be served in the shadow of the Soave castle at the near-by *Ristorante Al Gambero*. After lunch, depart the winery for the 1 ½ hour drive from Soave to the port in Venice, where you will board the ship in the late afternoon.
